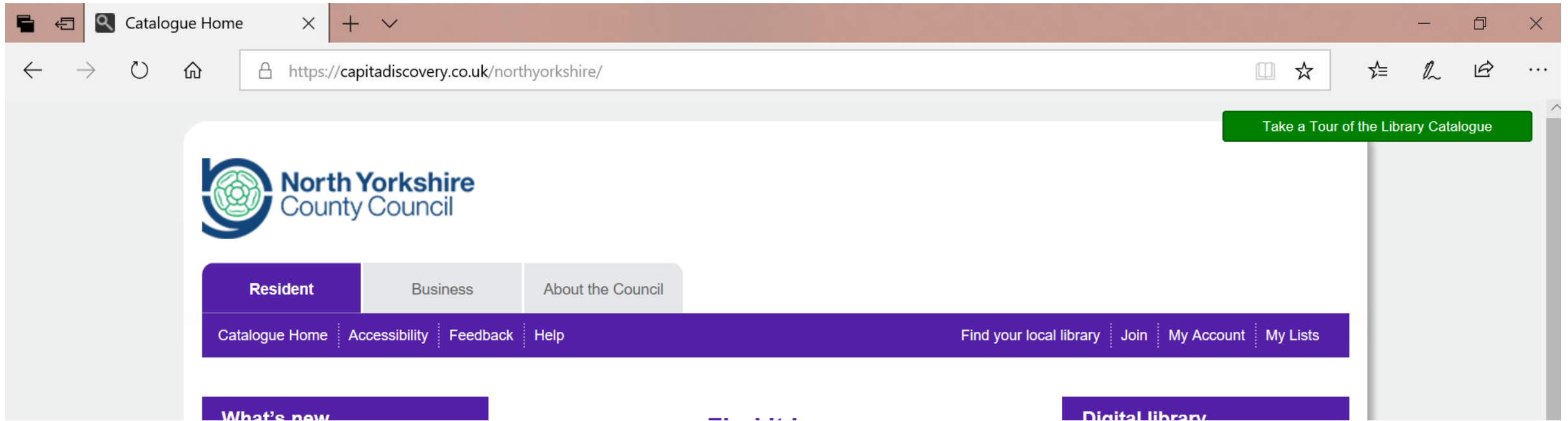

3. Type in the password **(this password must not be shared)**

Important information: FMP have informed us that, when using this temporary home access, users will not be able to log into their personal Findmypast account as they would normally be able to do when using the library subscription. For privacy reasons, FMP have advised that users should not start or update their own family trees on this account.

Under our agreement, the usage cap attached to this account is **5000 records per month**. If this is exceeded, North Yorkshire access will be suspended until the following month. We apologise for any inconvenience.
